Recognizing the arousal state within a child or child part and the techniques that will engage them in treatment.

Successful therapy is best when the client is fully engaged or in the window of tolerance. Through visual aids and videotaped case material, participants will develop skills in recognizing a client’s arousal state and increase

their comfort with moving clients into the window of tolerance. Creative language and play techniques will be demonstrated and can be utilized with children and young parts of adults. New strategies will be introduced to increase the capacity of a child or child part to feel safe during treatment as safety is an essential element in the healing of early trauma.

Julie Dubovoy is a Licensed Clinical Social Worker with a private practice in Babylon, NY. She is an EMDR certified therapist with Bachelors in Social Work from the University of Georgia and a Masters in Clinical Social Work from

Columbia University. Mrs. Dubovoy specializes and has lectured on the treatment of anxiety, depression, loss, and trauma with children and families. She also has been published in Jaleh Donaldson’s book: “Making Marriage a Success” (2011).
